On August 19th, Ford announced the introduction of a special appearance package for the 2022 Mustang EcoBoost Premium and GT Premium models (as well as the Mach E...whatever) that features an Oxford White exterior with pony badges and 19x9 heritage-inspired (reminiscent of the triple-white 1993 Fox body feature Mustang) white wheels with machined faces, a welcome change from the industry's trend toward black. The interior has black and white leather seats, door & console trim.

Think You Know Your Mustangs? (Sourced from Mustangmaniac.org by Jason Eager)

Here are some interesting facts you may or may not already know about your favorite Ford.

- In 1964, the Mustang's base price — \$2,368 — was featured prominently in the company's initial advertising. It was \$1,000 lower than that of the closest competition.



- Ford originally forecast about 100,000 Mustang sales in the first year. More than 400,000 were sold. (First year Camaro production in '67 was 220,906)
- The horse logo in the Mustang grille went through multiple versions, including what resembled a knight on a chessboard. Ford designers had the Mustang galloping to the right, similar to the way horses race on a track, and also moving left. Ultimately, Lee Iacocca said, "the Mustang is a wild horse, not a domesticated racer," and designer Gale Halderman felt the pony should always face left, the way designer Phil Clark first drew it.
